Low-performing schools are those that earn an overall school performance grade of D or F and a school growth score of "met expected growth" or "not met expected growth" as defined by G.S. 115C-83.15." TESS received a School Performance Grade of D and a growth designation of "met expected growth" for the 2021–2022 school year.
